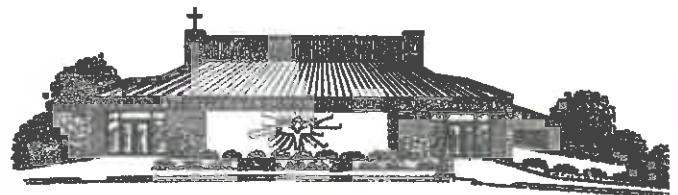

**Upcoming workshops:** **Preregistration ONLINE is required before attending a workshop.** You will be required to read monthly bulletins to remain approved to volunteer. See our web page for locations and dates.

**\*UPDATE from the Archdiocese: New Platform for Child Protection Training and Compliance Coming!**

#### **TO ALL PARISH VOLUNTEERS: NEW CHILD PROTECTION PLATFORM**

**In July 2021, the archdiocese will be moving to SafeParish as the new platform for Child Protection training and compliance.** SafeParish is an organization that specializes in training and education solutions for organizations world-wide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider – Selection.com. All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish. No new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS. Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees and will consist of quarterly interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins. **As the archdiocese moves closer to the conversion date, additional information regarding your new SafeParish account will be provided.** If you have questions, please contact your parish’s Safe Environment Coordinator.
