**INFANT BAPTISMS** – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the noon Mass and on the 4th Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. (outside of Mass). Parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Program, preferably 2 months prior to the birth of the child. The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Council Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

**NEW PARISHIONERS** – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS** – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

An evening with Deacon Dave Shea**



**Wednesday, May 8 at 7:00 PM in the Church Hall**

David J. Shea, a permanent deacon in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, was ordained in 1998. Deacon Shea will present a highly informative talk on the importance of proclaiming the Scriptures at Mass. Deacon Shea will touch on topics such as: good preparation; use of Lectio Divina, and how the proclamation of Sacred Scripture prepares us to celebrate the Eucharist. Having recently retired as the Associate Professor of Homiletics at the Athenaeum of Ohio/Mt. St. Mary’s Seminary where he taught for 15 years, Deacon Shea holds a B.S. in Industrial Management, an M.A. in Religion from the Athenaeum of Ohio, and a **Doctorate in Preaching from Aquinas Institute of Theology at St. Louis University**. David has been married to Jan for 49 years and conducts marriage and liturgical ministry workshops for parishes throughout the Archdiocese and teaches preaching courses for various dioceses across the country. We are grateful to Deacon Shea for coming to talk to our Readers for Mass, as well as all of us who desire to deepen our understanding of liturgy and scripture. 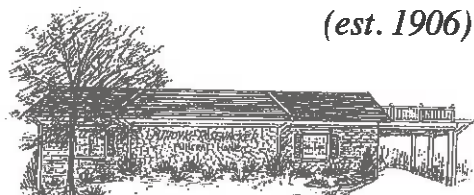
