PARISH OFFICE SUMMER HOURS

Starting **Friday, June 19th** the Parish Office will close at **12 Noon every Friday through July 31st**. The office will be open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 9 am to 4 pm.

Church Open

On Saturdays, the church will open in time for confessions at 12:30 p.m.

For morning Mass on weekdays, church will be open by 8:00 a.m. On Sunday, it will be open by 7:30 a.m.

We are trying to have church open for adoration at the tabernacle and private prayer from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday. Several times a week the church is being fully sanitized in the afternoons. That requires the church be closed during the procedure and remain closed for the rest of the afternoon.

Confessions: Father continues to hear Confessions at the regular time of 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. on Saturdays. **Beginning June 6, he will hear Confessions in the Hubble Rd. sacristy, next to the confessional.** There will be 6 feet distancing for both face-to-face and anonymous Confessions. Directions for waiting, etc., will be posted at the church doors.

We will not be using the Confession Room anytime soon. It is too small. This move will mean people can wait inside church and not gather in the entrances as they wait. They can also pray in church after going to Confession, and many people do use the Blessed Sacrament Chapel to pray after Confession.

The United States Bishops have designated June 22nd through June 29th as Religious Freedom Week. The Bishops invite us to pray, reflect, and take action on religious liberty, both here in this country and abroad.

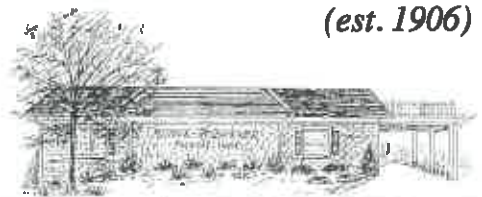
