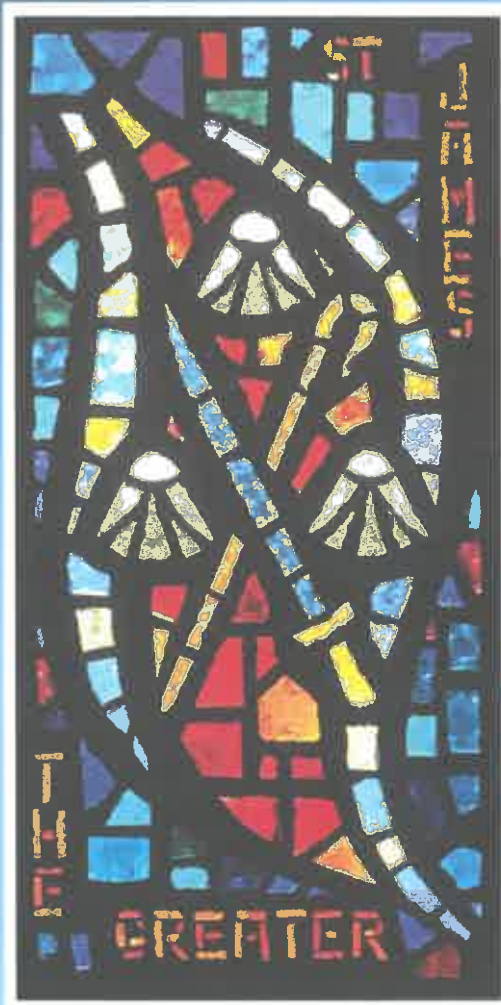

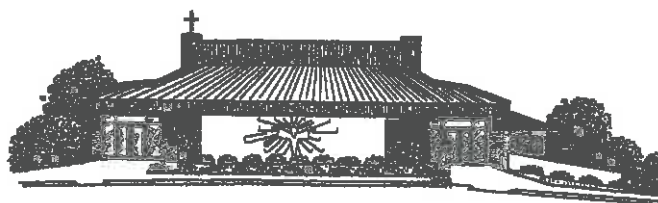

Beginning with the Sunday Masses of **June 6, 2021**, Archbishop Schnurr is reinstating the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Mass for the faithful of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

Since our guidance throughout this pandemic has been to follow the regulations of public health authorities, **there will be no mask mandate for churches of the archdiocese after the statewide mandate is lifted.**

As was announced in church on May 9, seating capacity at St. James was returned to full capacity except for 2 sections.

For details and requirements, please visit our web page, click the Parish Info Tab, then Archdiocese Child Protection Policy. **EVERYONE NEEDS** to complete the Selection.com background check through their VIRTUS account (cost is \$25). *This is a one-time requirement.*

Upcoming workshops: **Pre-registration ONLINE is required before attending a workshop.** You will be required to read monthly bulletins to remain approved to volunteer. See our web page for locations and dates.

#### **\*UPDATE from the Archdiocese: New Platform for Child Protection Training and Compliance Coming!**

#### **TO ALL PARISH VOLUNTEERS: NEW CHILD PROTECTION PLATFORM**

**In July 2021** the archdiocese will be moving to SafeParish as the new platform for Child Protection training and compliance. SafeParish is an organization that specializes in training and education solutions for organizations world-wide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider – Selection.com. All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish. No new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS. Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees and will consist of quarterly interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins. **As the archdiocese moves closer to the conversion date, additional information regarding your new SafeParish account will be provided.** If you have questions, please contact your parish’s Safe Environment Coordinator.

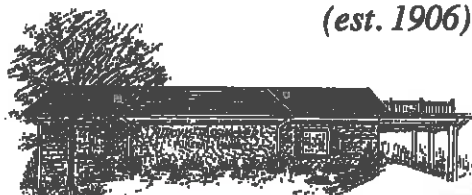
