Safe Parish is now active !

All Active Virtus Users will be invited 1st to register in Safe Parish. Look for emails from Safe Parish with instructions to register.

Instead of monthly bulletins there will be quarterly videos to watch and then answer a few questions. The 1st video will be available September 1, and you will have 30 days to complete. If you do not view the video in 30 days your account will be inactivated.

TO ALL PARISH VOLUNTEERS: NEW CHILD PROTECTION PLATFORM

In July 2021 the Archdiocese will be moving to SafeParish as the new platform for Child Protection training and compliance. SafeParish is an organization that specializes in training and education solutions for organizations world-wide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider – Selection.com. All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish. No new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS. Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees and will consist of quarterly interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins.
