For morning Mass on weekdays, church will be open by 8:00 a.m. On Sunday, it will be open by 7:30 a.m.

We are trying to have church open for Adoration at the tabernacle and private prayer from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday. Several times a week the church is being fully sanitized in the afternoons.

That requires the church be closed during the procedure and remain closed for the rest of the afternoon.

### Confessions: **NOTICE: NO confessions on Saturday, July 18th.**

**Normal hours:** Father continues to hear Confessions at the regular time of 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. on Saturdays.

He will hear Confessions in the Hubble Rd. sacristy, next to the Confessional. There will be 6 feet distancing for both face-to-face and anonymous Confessions. Directions for waiting, etc., will be posted at the church doors.

We will not be using the Confession Room anytime soon. It is too small. This move will mean people can wait inside church and not gather in the entrances as they wait. They can also pray in church after going to confession, and many people do use the Blessed Sacrament Chapel to pray after Confession.

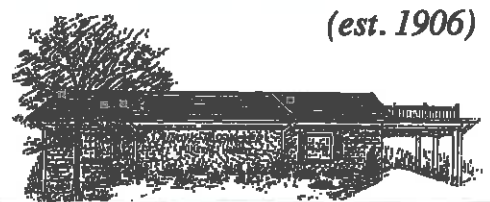
