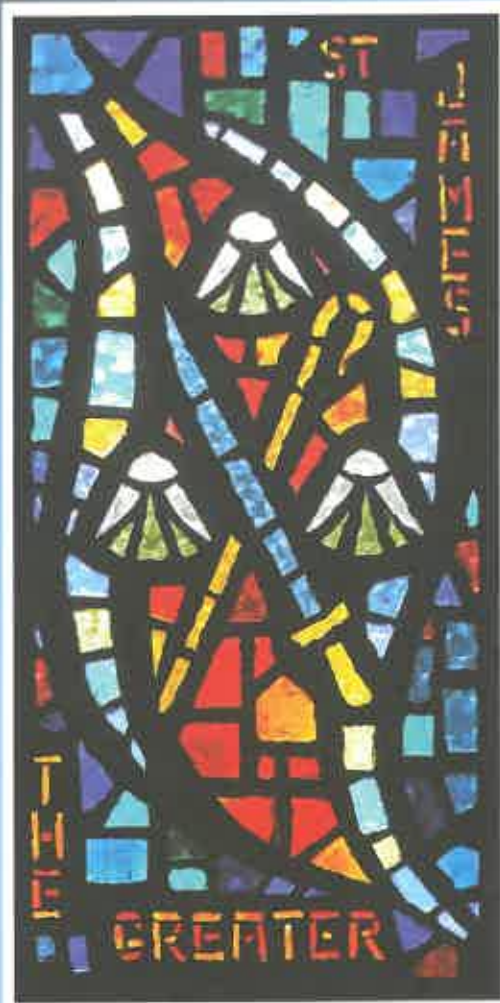

Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

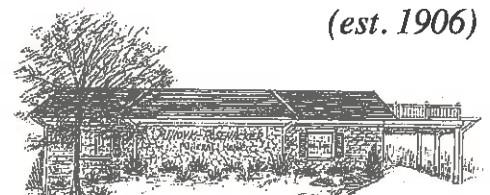
