CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

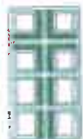

Active Parishioner Status Info

Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of St. James the Greater Parish. An "active member" of this parish is one who: **1.** Is properly registered and on the parish census. **2.** Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. **3.** Participates in parish activities when possible. **4.** Uses the parish envelope system.

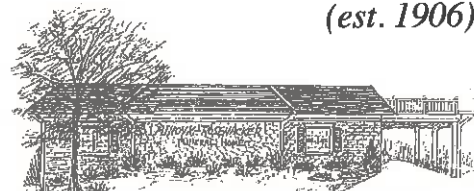
