FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Becoming Catholic: We are entering the peak time of the year for questions and interest about becoming Catholic. Although we are always eager for anyone interested in the Catholic faith, we coordinate our strongest efforts around the beginning of the school year simply because that seems to be the most convenient time for many. If you are interested in the Catholic faith, know someone who might be encouraged, or would like to help out, please call the St. Ann, St. Bernard, St. James, or St. Margaret Mary parish offices.

Readings for next week: Wisdom 9:13-18; Philemon 9-10, 12-17; Luke 14:25-33

Reflection: Sometimes a major event will inspire us to explore our relationship with God. More often, the reason behind our desire is something indefinable, a subtle tug to become involved in parish life, to give more time to our families, an emptiness that we have been unable to fill. Paul's conversion to Christ is deepened through a simple experience of friendship with a runaway slave. Philemon, a fellow Christian known to Paul, is in turn challenged by Paul's letter to see a man he legally owns, not as a slave but as a brother. Philemon's answer will represent either a deeper conversion to Christ's love, or a denial of him. Ultimately discipleship requires continual openness to conversion and challenge, a determination to overcome anything that might stand in our way, and a desire to follow ever more closely.

1. Name someone who has been faithful to you at a real personal cost. Give thanks.
2. Consider aspects of your life that may hinder you from following God.

Prayer: *Your devotion to the Father, Lord Jesus, is most clearly seen in your love for us. You are the bridge between us, loving tirelessly in an effort to bring all people together with their God. Help us now, Jesus, to love as you love, allowing nothing to inhibit us in our love for God or one another.*

With Summer activities in full swing, we would like to remind all parish/school employees and volunteers of the requirements of the Decree on Child Protection. All employees and volunteers are required to have completed The Archdiocese of Cincinnati SafeParish™: Protecting Children from Sexual Abuse – Archdiocese of Cincinnati Edition training or child protection training under the prior child protection platform (VIRTUS). In addition, employees are required to complete an online background check, manual fingerprints, and B4 form once prior to beginning employment. Ohio Department of Education licensees may have additional requirements and should check with their school office or athletic departments if there are any questions. Volunteers are required to complete an online background check prior to volunteering with youth. Employees and volunteers are required to stay current in completing SafeParish™ quarterly bulletins. As of July 8, there are 10,000+ SafeParish user accounts that are pending due to lack of compliance in completing the quarterly bulletins. With the school year beginning for most in August, please make sure to complete the quarterly bulletins or you will not be able to work/volunteer with youth until your SafeParish account is approved.
