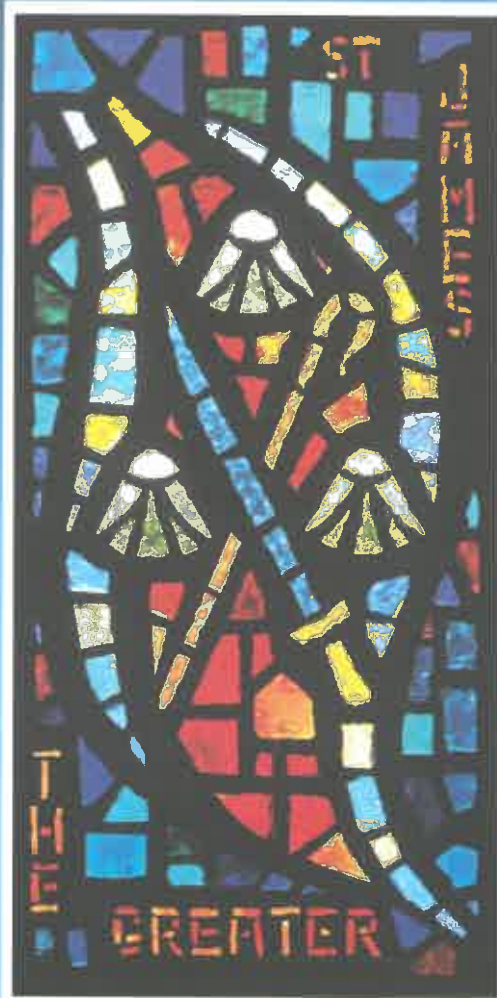

FORMED

St. Maximilian Kolbe, a Franciscan priest, was a prisoner in Auschwitz during World War II. In July of 1941, a prisoner escaped and in order to set an example, ten men were singled out to be starved to death. Father Maximilian, although not selected, volunteered to be the victim in place of one of the prisoners. He died on August 14. He is the patron saint of drug addicts, prisoners, families, and the pro-life movement. His feast is this Friday. Learn more about St. Maximilian in the movie "Life for Life: Maximilian Kolbe."

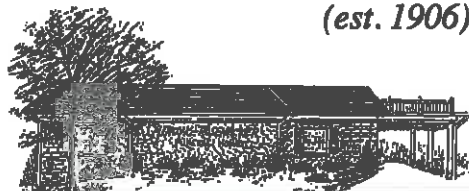
