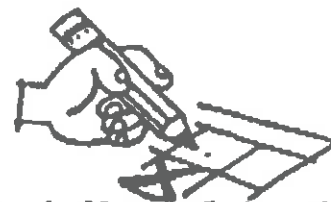

We receive many requests from parishioners to qualify for weddings here, or to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an **“active member”** of St. James the Greater Parish. An **“active member”** of this parish is one who: **1.** Is properly registered and on the parish census. **2.** Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. **3.** Participates in parish activities when possible. **4.** Uses the parish envelope system.

NOTE: An adult child living at home should register as themselves or please notify the Parish Office when they no longer live at home with the parents.

While assessments of an inquirer’s status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination.
