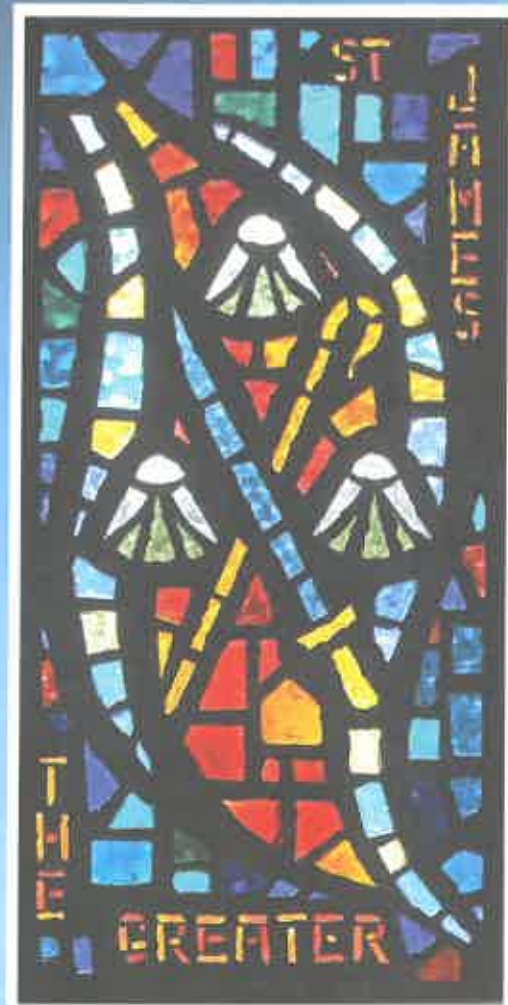

The program is held on the 2nd THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH in the Council Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. Godparents are also encouraged to attend. Please pre-register by calling the Parish Office. Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

NEW PARISHIONERS – Please register in person at the Parish Office as soon as possible.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS OR PARISHIONER STATUS – Please notify the Parish Office if you have had a change of address or phone number, or if a member of your family has gone into a nursing facility or moved out of the household.

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)

What is Children's Liturgy of the Word? First and foremost, CLOW is liturgy, ritual prayer and not catechesis (religious instruction) or child care. Its purpose is not to give the children activities to do so the adults can listen to the homily upstairs in peace! It is as much a part of the Mass as what the adults are doing upstairs. Because it is a liturgical celebration, all the principles of good liturgy apply. Included are active participation and clear symbols that are appropriate to the liturgical year. The Book of God's Word is handled with respect, the Word is proclaimed clearly and reverently, and the reflections are aimed at guiding the children and listening to what they have heard rather than telling the children what we think they are supposed to hear. The purpose is to enable the children

to take a more conscious and active part in the liturgical celebration that will eventually lead to their full participation with the adult assembly.

CLOW Ministers

Leader - Welcomes the children, proclaims the Gospel, leads the reflection on the Scriptures, leads the Profession of Faith and the Prayer of The Faithful.

Lector - Proclaims the first Scripture reading. Reads the responsorial Psalm and Gospel Acclamation if there is no Cantor.

Cantor - Sings the Responsorial Psalm and Gospel Acclamation. May lead the children in song if there is time remaining.

Hospitality Minister - Prepares the space for the celebration. Tends to any special needs that might arise, making sure the children feel comfortable and welcome.

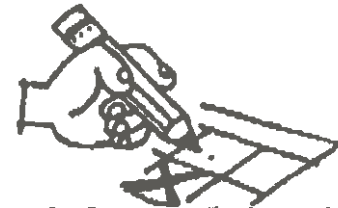

Active Parishioner Status Info

We receive many requests from parishioners to qualify for weddings here, or to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an “active member” of St. James the Greater Parish. An “active member” of this parish is one who: **1.** Is properly registered and on the parish census. **2.** Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. **3.** Participates in parish activities when possible. **4.** Uses the parish envelope system.

NOTE: An adult child living at home should register as themselves or please notify the Parish Office when they no longer live at home with the parents.

While assessments of an inquirer’s status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination. **If you would like to update your information and/or inquire about your membership status, or if you do not receive our Quarterly Parish Life Newsletter or yearly Sunday contribution envelopes, you are inactive in our parish database.**

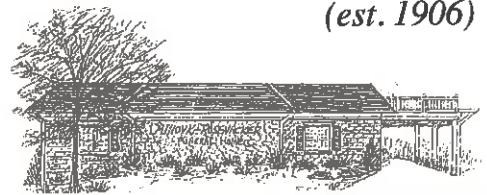
