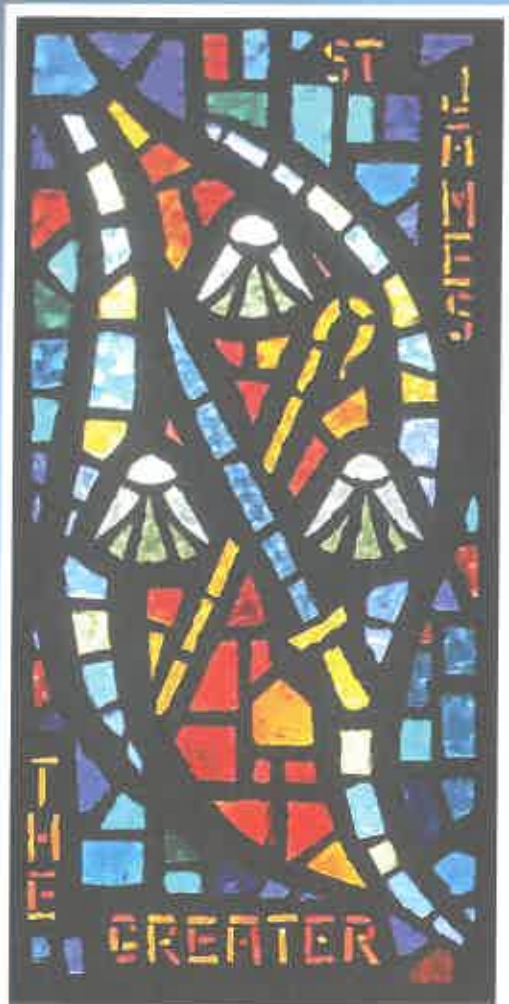

Baptisms will be scheduled after attending the program.

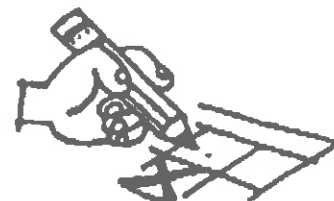

Mission Appeal

THIS weekend September 7-8, Sr. Dorothy Fabritze, MSC, representing the Circus Ministry, will be in the parish to talk about her work among the itinerant communities of the circus. The Catholic Church in the USA has a history of reaching out to these communities since the 1920s. These often neglected traveling communities have the same spiritual needs to be educated in their faith, receive the sacraments and be spiritually fed. Unfortunately, because they do not have roots in any geographical location, they do not have the physical structures that would provide for this need. Sr. Dorothy will be HERE to speak about her experiences of traveling with the circus people for 19 years, her ministry to these people, and some exciting plans for the future.

Active Parishioner Status Info

We receive many requests from parishioners to qualify for weddings here, or to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an “active member” of St. James the Greater Parish. An “active member” of this parish is one who: **1.** Is properly registered and on the parish census. **2.** Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. **3.** Participates in parish activities when possible. **4.** Uses the parish envelope system.

NOTE: An adult child living at home should register as themselves or please notify the Parish Office when they no longer live at home with the parents.

While assessments of an inquirer’s status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination. **If you would like to update your information and/or inquire about your membership status, or if you do not receive our Quarterly Parish Life Newsletter or yearly Sunday contribution envelopes, you are inactive in our parish database.**

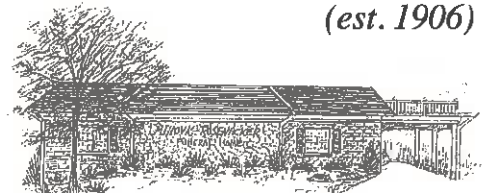
