# St James Parish Council Meeting

# October 7, 2020

- COVID provided an opportunity for families to reconnect and grow closer.
- COVID provided an opportunity to realize how blessed we are with all the things we have in our possession.

# **Report on Religious Education**

- Claire Zink shared the Religious Programs and how they are being handled this year with COVID restrictions.
  - School masses are being attended by school children on a weekly rotating basis
    - 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> grade
    - 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade
    - 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade
  - o 5<sup>th</sup> grade has done a Rosary Service in the past. This year each 5<sup>th</sup> grader wrote an intention on a square and Claire arranged them in a Rosary pattern in the vestibule for everyone to view.
  - PSR is being taught at home via the parents. Claire & a few Catechist meet with the PSR attendees
    and their parents on a monthly basis. The parents have said they are learning things with their kids.
     We have 10 families / 13 students in PSR this year.
  - First Communion for 3<sup>rd</sup> graders who did not get to celebrate their First Communion last year due to COVID are celebrating at 4:30 masses in October
    - 24 students participated on October 3<sup>rd</sup>
    - 21 students will participate on October 10<sup>th</sup>
    - 22 students will participate on October 17<sup>th</sup>
    - It was decided to celebrate First Communion at 4:30 mass because they were supposed to all celebrate at 4:30 mass last year and 4:30 mass has the lowest attendance of our weekend masses and this allowed extended family to attend the celebration.
  - Confirmation
    - planned for February 8, 2021 at 7 pm
    - 57 students will be making their Confirmation
    - The plan is to only have the student, their sponsor and their parents attend the celebration.
    - Archbishop Schnur will be the celebrant
  - First Reconciliation
    - 64 66 students
    - 3 times slots will be assigned to student & their parents
      - 7:00 pm
      - 7:30 pm
      - 8:00 pm
    - There will be a scripture reflection then the students will celebrate reconciliation then parents if they want to.
    - Students and parents will wait in the Church Hall before their time

## Cathedral ornament update

- Nancy Thomas brought the 2 Parish ornaments 1 to go to the Cathedral and 1 to put on our Christmas Tree. Fr Nolker will take it down to the cathedral next week.
- Karen Wiseman is working with the students of St James to create the ornament from the School. She will have it finished before Thanksgiving. The students are thinking about make a cross ornament with possibly a fisherman, net, shell on it.
- Nancy sent a Thank You and St James prayer card to all the people who created the ornament.
- Nancy also gave everyone in Pastoral Council a St James prayer card THANK YOU NANCY!

## **Giving Tree**

- Connie Lanter asked if we think St James should do a Giving Tree this year and if we do should we cut back on the # of ornaments due to the reduction in people attending masses to fill the ornaments.
- Pastoral Council input to Father:
  - Yes continue the Giving Tree
  - o Reduce the # of ornaments on the tree
    - Focus on Christmas Oriented requests
    - Focus on Kid gifts
    - Focus on Organizations that St James still has affiliations with
    - ~650 tags would be a good #. ~450 people are attending weekend mass during COVID.

#### **Pastor's Comments**

#### Christmas Mass Schedule

- Should we keep the same Christmas mass schedule as past years we recommended keep the same or drop Noon mass
  - Christmas Eve 3pm (~1,000 attendees), 5 pm (~900 attendees)
  - Christmas Day 10 am (~250 attendees) & Noon (~275 attendees)
- Should we have pre-registration for Christmas masses This doesn't seem to have worked for other parishes.
- Will we have the Live Streaming equipment to be able to Stream in the Church Hall if over capacity in the church? Deacon Tim thinks equipment may be ready by Christmas. If it is, we could offer Live Streaming during Christmas masses.

## - COVID Weekend Mass Attendance

- We are averaging 400 people total at weekend masses
- o Prior to COVID we were averaging 1000 people total at weekend masses
